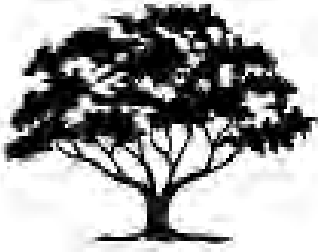

## GATE ENTRY INFO UPDATE

All Homeowners should go on-line to check their Entry Gate Information to make certain it is accurate, especially your correct email address, telephone number, permanent visitor and vendor names listed and the vehicles registered to your home is also accurate and correct. If you find your vehicle still has the VIN number listed and you now have a License Plate, please be certain to provide DHVCA with the new and correct data.

There are two entry lanes leading into the Birchknoll

Entry Gate. The left lane, the one nearest to the Guard House, is the lane for visitors, guests or vendors and the right lane, is the lane for residents with proper vehicle DHVCA stickers and transponders, which will open the gate. If the vehicle you are driving does not have a transponder then you are to use the visitor or guest lane (the left lane) and, if you are coming through the visitor or guest lane, please be prepared to show your ID.

## STREET PARKING ISSUE

As most homeowners and residents are aware, the Board is considering changes to street parking rules; in the meantime everyone who parks at Dominguez Hills Village can help to relieve some pressure on the availability of street parking by following **current rules**: 1) no vehicle, which shall be operational and currently registered with DMV, shall be parked on the streets for more than 72 hours without being moved no less than 25 feet and 2) no homeowner shall convert their garage to any use which prevents its use for vehicular parking for the number of vehicles owned by the homeowner. Violations of these two rules significantly effects street parking availability so please cooperate with Association's Parking Rules.
